

To post events on this site, you must:

- be a CVMG member in good standing
- have an event related to motorcycles (particularly older ones) of interest to CVMG members
- not post objectionable material
- post material which is in the public domain or for which you own copyright
- email at least the following details to events@CVMG.ca :
 - Event Title (works best if 30 characters or less)
 - start date and time and, if applicable, end date and time
 - a paragraph about the event
 - a photo or poster related to the event
 - contact information (name, email and or telephone contacts) for the event
 - your contact information (if different from above), so we can contact you with any questions
- if this event has occurred before, we can copy the original and modify it to your instructions. Just give us the name and date of the old event

When the events administrator receives the information, it will be reviewed for relevance and placed in the calendar. Preference will be given to events organized by CVMG Sections and/or those heavily attended by the membership. Rejection of an event will be at the sole discretion of the CVMG, with notification to the requestor.

Some suggestions for building better event details:

- 'a picture is worth a thousand words', so consider creating a poster or flyer to include in the event details.
- We prefer a jpg format file, but a pdf format will also work. This will allow you to combine images and event descriptions on a single page.
- Please limit the poster to 1 page, ideally in portrait orientation
- Try to keep the size of the file below 100Kb, as some members have trouble downloading large files.
- Alternatively, you can submit a large file and the events administrator will include it in the events detail as an optional download (for an example of this, see the Ganaraska 250 event on May 24, 2014. In this example, a small poster is initially displayed, but viewers can click to download and view a more readable version should they wish).

If you need to register participants to your event:

this website contains an application to setup a registration form and allow participants to register online. Contact the events administrator (by email: events@CVMG.ca) to learn more.
