Dear Vintage M/C Enthusiast,

Glen & Peter Wilson attended the C.V.M.G main body AGM on Saturday November 14th 1987. Glen gave a brief account of the proceedings- the result of the elections and the names and titles of the newly elected officers. This will be circulated when available.

Glen is now the C.V.M.G Membership Secretary and all prospective Great Pine Ridge section members should forward their applications to him for processing. Motorcycle Shows and Exhibitions were discussed at some length. The idea of exhibiting suitable motorcycles in shopping malls was presented for consideration. Glen will check out the Insurance requirements for this type of event, and whether the C.V.M.G insurance will cover properly sanctioned events.

The upcoming formal shows were discussed the first being in January at the International Centre for which not too much enthusiasm was shown due to the bad loading and unloading provisions which have been very poor in the past.

The second show is in February at the 'EX' and last year C.V.M.G had a very excellent stand. Glen will confirm with the main body what thier intentions are for 1988 as a number of our members would like to participate. The third show is at the Pickering Trade Centre in late March. This includes custom cars, trucks and motorcycles. A number of our section have exhibited there in previous years and were treated well. It has good access, free

parking etc.:. There was plenty of interest for this event and for those who are interested contact Doug Warwick, Warren Wheeler or Stan Dilley for more information.

Some fund raising ideas were presented for discussion including the sale of some type of affiliated product at shows and exhibitions. Stan will investigate this to ascertain if the show organizers will allow this as there may be conflicts of interest.

Coming events for the 1988 season were discussed including road runs, barbecues and flea markets. Warren showed interest in stageing a road run and barbecue in late July, similar to previous years but on a very much smaller scale. Andrew Boson and others showed interest in organizing road runs.

Any other ideas would be welcomed.

The meeting was adjoured by Glen and seconded by Warren Wheeler.
