Where is this event held?

- The Grand Prix Circuit of Canadian Tire Motorsports Park
- CTMP is located at 3233 Concession Rd 10, Bowmanville, ON L1C 3K6
- Entry via the main gate from Concession Road 10
- Map and directions here

When does the event run?

- Friday August 11 through Sunday August 13, 2023
- 9am 5pm each day

What can I do there?

- Watch vintage bikes race from several viewing spots at one of the best road racing tracks in North America
- Walk the pit area and meet riders and support crew
- Buy or sell motorcycle parts and accessories in the swap meet
- Participate in the judged motorcycle concours either as a spectator or by entering a bike in the competition
- Enjoy the live band on Saturday evening
- Camp for the weekend for free

Swap Meet

What's a swap meet?

- If you have motorcycles, parts or related items, such as books or magazines, then come and sell them at the swap meet. There's no food or clothing sold at the swap meet

Does it cost anything to be a vendor?

- You must have a valid Participant ticket with the additional Hot Pit access to be a vendor or a buyer
- There is no additional fee to sell swap meet items
- You do not need to register as a vendor

Can I reserve a spot in the swap meet area?

- The swap meet area is located in a large open area without individually marked vendor spots
- There are no reserved spots in the swap meet area. It is first come, first served

Can I sell stuff from my race pit?

- Yes

Motorcycle Concours

What's a Concours?

- The full name is Concours d'Elegance originally a French term referring to a competition judged on the appearance of vehicles
- In this concours, motorcycles will be divided into classes for competition and street
- Experienced judges will use a points system to objectively assess each entry on its authenticity, appearance and other qualities
- Prizes will be awarded for top entries in each class

What time is the Concours?

- It takes place on Saturday of the Vintage Festival weekend
- Concours registration starts and 9:30am and finishes at 11:00am
- Judging starts at 2:30pm, with awards presented at 3pm
- Bikes must remain on display in the concours paddock until 3pm

Does it cost anything to enter a bike?

- You must have a valid Participant ticket with the additional Hot Pit access
- There is no additional fee to enter one or more bikes in the concours event
