

2024 CVMG Annual Members Meeting

Organizational Status as at 12 April 2024

Hosted by the Saskatchewan Section of the Canadian Vintage Motorcycle Group (CVMG), the Annual Members Meeting (AMM) is to be held at the **Saskatoon Western Development Museum** (WDM) at 2935 Lorne Avenue in Saskatoon Friday June 7, 2024 until Sunday June 9.

A “Meet and Greet” will be held Friday, June 7th at 18h30 (6:30 pm) at **Ffun Motorcycle Company**, 635 Circle Drive in Saskatoon. Plenty of dealer bikes (*Ducati, Triumph, BMW, Royal Enfield*) and previously loved machines will be on the showroom floor plus a large lot out front for our ‘cycling guests’ to park and admire their machines. We are serving “A Tiny Taste of Saskatchewan” as finger-food, featuring locally sourced and prepared specialties. Quantities are limited (have supper first, but leave room!) and make sure to register in advance.

The **Western Development Museum** will open its doors to registered AMM attendees at 9h (9 am) on Saturday morning, June 8. WARNING: The Meeting is set to begin at 10h (10 am). No search parties will be sent! The Meeting is scheduled to end at 15h (3pm) and will include a fine Ukrainian lunch. The Museum remains open until 17h (5 pm), allowing our guests to finish their morning tour.

On Sunday, June 9th the Saskatchewan Section invites its out-of-town guests on rides of various distances. One is sure to suit your fancy: **Please Note:** Let us know if you require passenger space in a four-wheeled vehicle for any of the rides.

- A run to John Bennett’s farm and motorcycle collection near Biggar, Saskatchewan. Biggar is the site of our annual Biggar Bike Rally. The guided trip is approximately 100 kms one-way and will include a stop at a local restaurant for a delicious (and inexpensive) lunch.
- A shorter, guided trip to **The Berry Barn** featuring a Saskatoon Berry plantation, home-style food in a restaurant overlooking the South Saskatchewan River and lovely souvenirs for purchase. The trip is approximately 30 kms one-way.
- Another guided trip to **Big Mur’s Tavern** in Dundurn may be offered. This 50 km one-way trip features an indoor or outdoor dining “adventure” in a restaurant / tavern decorated with motorcycles, trucks, buses, drilling equipment and the like. Obviously, there would be nothing here to interest any self-respecting biker group. The food is very good too!
- An in-town guided trip to the Saskatchewan Aviation Museum is available and may also act as our “fall-back” option in case of weather. Not only will you be guided to the Museum, but knowledgeable guides will explain the (not always so) high-flying exhibits. This Museum is about 10 kms away from the WDM.
